

## **Apple System Recommendations**

While you **can** bring your Apple laptop to use for the hands-on portion of this course, I strongly advise AGAINST it. While all of the software has MacOS versions, there are specific step-by-step following along with me demonstrating each step along the way. Additionally, keystrokes and shortcuts are much different between Mac and PC. Ultimately, using a Mac will be difficult for you to follow along with me, however, if you are *proficient* at MacOS and don't want to have to buy a PC laptop only for this course, you are welcome to bring it for the hands-on software use.
