The In-Person Exhibit Hall

Hinman’s Exhibit Hall will be located in the Grand Ballroom of the Omni Hotel and will feature approximately 70 booths. The Virtual Exhibit Hall

Hinman’s Virtual Exhibit Hall can be accessed from any device, from anywhere in the world. Registered attendees can log into the Virtual Exhibit Hall 24/7 on March 12th and 13th and will have access to more than 100 virtual exhibitors. In addition, exhibitors will be available to chat online Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Saturday from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. EST.

Those participating virtually will be asked on March 10th to set up a profile for the virtual platform. Then, they will have access to the Virtual Exhibit Hall and courses. Two product demonstration courses will be offered virtually this year. Seven companies will demonstrate the latest products and services, and attendees will be awarded an hour of CE in the process.
