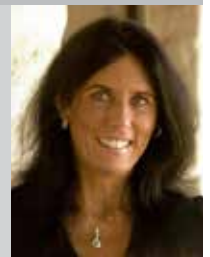

Hinman Student Research Symposium Celebrates Twenty-Fourth Year

Last year marked the 24th anniversary of the Hinman Student Research Symposium at the University of Tennessee. The event was held November 2-4, 2018 at the historic Peabody Hotel in Memphis, Tennessee. The Hinman Dental Society has been a co-sponsor of the event since its inception.

The Symposium featured oral and poster presentations of research projects by dental students and graduate trainees from dental schools across North America. At this year's Symposium, 108 students represented 56 dental schools in 32 states, Puerto Rico and six provinces of Canada. The Symposium rewards and encourages student efforts in research and supports the research and educational programs of faculty research mentors and research administrators.

The Symposium was also sponsored by the University of Tennessee College of Dentistry. In addition, the Symposium was supported in part by grants from the National Institute for Dental and Craniofacial Research (NIDCR), the ADEA Gies Foundation, the Procter & Gamble Company, the University of Tennessee College of Dentistry Alumni Association and the Tennessee Dental Association Foundation.

Hinman was represented by Dr. Roy McDonald and his wife, Debbie. Dr. McDonald shared with us... "Debbie and I really enjoyed our time in Memphis. All of the students who participated in the symposium were incredibly impressive. It was an honor to represent Hinman. After spending the weekend surrounded by so many bright and hard-working students, I feel confident in the future of dentistry."

CALL TO ORDER: President-elect Sedgie Newsom called the meeting to order at 7:06 p.m.

MINUTES: Secretary David Anderson presented the minutes from the September Executive Council and Membership Meeting as printed in the November *Hinman Preview Review*. The minutes were approved (Anderson/Rousseau).

FINANCE: Treasurer Troy Schulman presented the current Year-to-Date Society Financial statement. The statement was approved as follows (Schulman/Rousseau):

His team is working on editing the Pre-Registration book now. He is looking forward to the upcoming Committee Chair Dinner.

HINMAN 2020: Chair-elect Bob O'Donnell is supporting 2019. The 2020 program team has invited approximately half of their speakers, and they look forward to scouting more over the next few months. He is proud to be working with an excellent team, Drs. Jane Puskas and William Rousseau.

HINMAN 2021: Vice Chair-elect Kate Robinson is supporting Hinman 2019 and is looking forward to attending the 2019 Meeting. She recently returned from scouting at ADA in Hawaii and plans to attend the upcoming Yankee and Chicago Mid-Winter meetings.

ADVISORY: Chair Pat Yancey has no report
